The Western State University Library is a private library. Its sole mission is to serve the educational and research needs of our students, faculty and staff. Therefore, the general public is not permitted to use the library at any time. Those not eligible to use the library may be referred to the Orange County Law Library at 515 North Flower, Santa Ana (714) 834-3397, and other county law libraries.

***All patrons, including Western State University students, must be prepared to present an ID. People from the following groups may use the law library with the following conditions:***

<u>GROUP</u>	<u>CONDITION</u>
WSU Graduates	Alumni card or are on alumni list
Member of any State Bar	Valid bar card (indicating ability to currently practice law)
Members of the Judiciary	Valid ID
CSUF faculty, staff and students	Must have current CSUF ID card and proof of an assignment that requires legal research
Faculty and students from ABA-, WASC-, and CBE "Rule 18"-accredited law schools (SEE LIST at Reserve Desk)	Valid law school ID card
Foreign attorneys	Valid ID that indicates status
